## Aircraft

**AC1** 1/72 scale and smaller aircraft all types

**AC2** 1/71<sup>st</sup> to 1/33 scale all types (primarily 1/48 scale)

**AC3** 1/32 scale and larger all types

## Science Fiction and Space

**SP1** Real spacecraft, missiles, and vehicles all scales

**SP2** Science Fiction TV, movies, and print subjects all scales not to include Mecha, gunplay, or anime type models.

**SP3** Mecha, Gunpla, and Anime type subjects all scales.

## Military Vehicles and Equipment

**MV1** 1/48th and smaller

**MV2** 1/47<sup>th</sup> and larger 1945 and earlier

**MV3** 1/47<sup>th</sup> and larger 1946 and later

**MV4** Non-Armored with or without weapons all types and scales.

**MV5** Artillery. Smooth or rifled bore, muzzle or breech loaded and Weaponized Rockets, Missiles and Rocket Artillery

**FG1** Busts, all types, and scales

**FG2** 54mm and smaller

**FG3** 55mm and larger

**FG4** Fantasy and Gaming figures

**FG5** Animals past and present

## Dioramas, Vignettes and Shadow Boxes

**DR1** 1/72<sup>nd</sup> and smaller

**DR2** 1/48<sup>th</sup> (1/71<sup>st</sup> to 1/34<sup>th</sup>)

**DR3** 1/35<sup>th</sup> and larger

## Ships

**SH1** 1/500<sup>th</sup> and smaller all types

**SH2** 1/499<sup>th</sup> and larger all types

## Automotive

**AT1** Replica or Factory stock all types

**AT2** Curbside and Slammers

**AT3** Hot Rods, Street Machines, and Customs all years

**AT4** Competition, all

**AT5** Light Commercial A vehicle typically considered a family car/truck that has been put into commercial use as a Police Vehicle, Taxi, Ambulance, Tow Truck, Ramp Truck, Etc. These vehicles will typically have some sort of markings showing a company or municipal name/logo.

**AT6** Heavy Commercial and Farm Implements

## Box Build

**BB1** Box Built all types and scales. Kit instructions must be presented at registration and must be left on the judging table for judging. Only details shown in the kit directions may be added to the model. Bare Metal Foil and the use of Aftermarket Decals are Allowed.

## Junior

**JR1** age 12 and under all scales and types

**JR2** age 13 to 17 all scales and types

Junior modelers may enter the junior category or standard category but not both.

## 4Me

**4 Me** Special needs Modelers all types

## Miscellaneous

**MS1** Any model that does not fit into any other category.
